Mobility Project.... "A Different Perspective"

In July 2014, we have provided special vehicles to Ex candidates; Irfan Pathan and Yuvraj Ahire under this project. Special donations of Rs. 70000/- each received from Onjal Group and Mr. Abhijit Vaidya for this project. Thus creating Rs.140000/- as Earmarked Fund against this project and special vehicle provided to these ex candidate as "Interest Free Vehicle Loan".

Make My Dream Foundation is always offering better opportunities to its candidates for "Self Reliance" with the tool of financial support and an idea of providing loan emerged out of in-depth thought of "Self Reliance".

After successful accomplishment of "Self Reliance" in respect of basic necessities and education for about 1-2 years by these candidates, we came up with great solution for mobility hardships faced by them.

Presently, these candidates being earning very little just adequate for basic necessities and education, they are not eligible to get loan for vehicle from any financial institution for at least next 5-6 years. But then such hectic daily chorus requiring lot of physical efforts shall definitely affect their active health negatively. Already they are sufferer on the front of impaired physis and such negative progression on health front will definitely reduce their work efficiency at least by 10 years ultimately.

Solution: "They need a Special Vehicle, which will reduce extra strain on their body".

So we decided to come ahead and solve this issue with different perspective keeping their self dignity and self reliance intact.

Success : So went for interest free loan and for past 6 months they are repaying the monthly instalment of Rs.1000/- without fail with the increased earning efficiency.

Shortly we shall be in position to provide one more candidate a special vehicle with these "Recycled Funds".

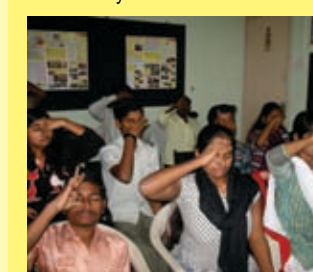
Isn't it Innovative! The hands, which had habit of receiving from society because

In earlier organizations, where they have brought up till 10th standard, the approach and environment is over protective considering their age and thus these children get isolate from the society. Thus their perspective towards life is too isolated, conservative leading to many more negativities in character.

I feel through counseling, personality development sessions they have been given manifold inputs but whether they have consumed it or it is just at superficial level can be tested through the hardest missions like "Sinhgad Trek".

A lecture in closed room would have been boring and ineffective. So experiments like "Sinhgad Trek" realises and helps them to implement such inputs practically. That day they all were here in the eyes of physically normal peoples and their courage to climb Sinhgad motivated the physically normal ones. That night they massaged each other and realised the importance of group activities and success. They realised that they also can motivate the society.

So in one mission, we could able to achieve a lot and thats why its a real mile stone.....

Such innovative thoughts force us to launch "Nutritional Diet Program" in this year. With the help of volunteers, we could successfully accomplish the task easily. Inclusion of Yoga, Accupressure Exercise, Healthy Breakfast, Dry Fruit Breakfast and Healthy Lunch made the program successful.

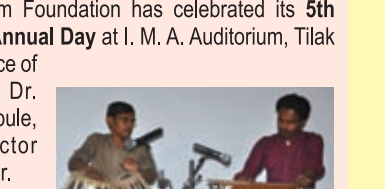
