From the Desk of Managing Trustee...

Hello Everybody,

I am always glad when I get a chance to connect you all through the newsletter. It gives me immense pleasure in communicating to you about the experiences of the past six months. Again, a bundle of energetic activities, contentment and enthusiastic success stories...



For me the very essence of education is concentration of mind and not only collection of facts. The action and reactions of mind and physical body goes hands in hand. However, the power of mind is much finer and more powerful than the body.

Normally everybody acquires self-reliance physical and financial but then what about self-reliance in emotional and thinking process. We give emphasis to the later self-reliance. Through follow up and one to one counseling sessions, our candidates exposed to the importance of removal of negative barriers about handicap ness, self-discipline, time management, decision-making and improvisation of values of life in every aspect.

Their real problems are not merely education, clothes, shelter & artificial limb. Actually, they need personal attention to strengthen their inner potential and personality.

I have been asked many times that what is different in our program. I can say, we are not doing anything different but we are doing the things differently. With some value additions, we are trying to overcome the real problems faced by these special children. Let me elaborate...

In spite of qualification, they are jobless, very few succeeded in creating position in a society, many times neglected by the society, even at home.

I do not see the society is the only cause for these problems. These candidates do possess the degree but if they do not acquire soft skills required for any job, they mostly fail in securing the job. We say if these children wish to create position in a society, they must come forward with their real qualities and prove. These children should keep in their mind that they have to compete with the physically able ones with the positive strength of their inner potential. I am confident that then nobody will dare to refuse them. Therefore, for me the duty of the society & candidate's duty towards their own goes hands in hand.

My experience is that these candidates carry negative emotions about their physical disability strongly and they always try to refuse this vital fact. They take it granted that it is natural and they do not want to come out of their shell. For performing a respectable job or for holding a good position in the society, one must possess a good amount of self-respect and should be confident about own abilities. It's a self-image created by own and which reflects by the response from the society.

If one appears for the interview with thought carrying in mind, like "Will they doubt about mobility? Whether I can compete with the other candidates?" this suspect increases the fear factor, which leads to reduction in confidence, and the performance goes down unnoticed. In reality, they might be superior to the candidates present there, but ultimately they fail in securing that job. Then the person starts blaming to his luck, physical disability, society and bad environment. Of course, the duty of the society is vice versa means they should not refuse to the right candidates just giving such unfair reasons.

For removing these negative barriers about physical disability, we had arranged adventurous task of climbing of Rajmachi Fort on 23rd December, 2012. All our candidates courageously climbed it in just unbelievable timing of 2 hours and made a lifetime success story. It is a great achievement and the reactions of all are full of energy, thrilling as if they climbed Mount Everest. Yes, for them it is like climbing of Mount Everest.

This event realizes all of them that now they can do anything and nothing is impossible for them now in this world. They themselves started feeling like a normal person and they started leading towards a normal life.

We are proud that our success rate about removal of negative barriers about physical disability prevails between 80-100%.

With this, I conclude that our candidates i.e. the stars of Make My Dream have make over their mind that they are complete in all respect and advancing towards achievement of theirs dreams / goals.

Through our rehabilitation program, our children are receiving many more opportunities like quality education, motivational books, health upkeep, personality development, communication skills and entertainment. They are now positioned to prove themselves as a good human being, a responsible citizen

Purity, patience and perseverance are the three essentials of success and above all love. Three things are necessary to make every man great,

- ❖ Absence of jealousy and suspicion
- Helping all who are trying to be and do good

We try to make these candidates to see the real world coming out of our own shell, realize the problems beyond self and try to be of helping nature. Our candidate visits various NGO's, hospitals, old age homes and meets with the grannies, grandpas, orphans, fellow sufferers and try to heal the others wounds just having a caring communication.

Unique Counseling / Personality Development

Our aim is to provide varied opportunities of education and self-reliance to these candidates with the tool of personality transformation. We know, it is difficult to achieve this at their teenage but our endeavor is constantly making the efforts towards this direction. Normally our support program is designed for 2 years span, so we know erasing the wrong, illusions and making it ideal is just not possible in 2 years. I can say our success rate goes up to 50% in 2 years. However, we try to give 100% input during these 2 years so when in future in any circumstances, they will recollect all and can handle the situation positively. Therefore, for us whatever they have told is not a waste and will be useful for their lifetime.

In our weekly Personality Development Sessions, motivational lectures by guest speakers, these children are exposed to soft skills, behavioral problems, attitude change, perception about life, introduction to their self and many more. Through guest speakers / professionals, they are exposed to health awareness, exercise, yoga and meditation.

We give emphasis on quality life and preserving values in life. If we consider humanity, there is an end towards which every human is moving i.e. perfection. It is a weakness to think that someone is dependent on you.
