Working efficiency of both the candidates, who have been supported with special vehicles in 2014 has turned the corner. Our motive behind launching of such innovative idea of "Interest Free Vehicle Loans" to these special ones not only made successful by these in candidates but also received increasing appreciation from donors because of provoking thought of "Creating Manifold Helping Hands through Support" behind it with the simple tool of recycle of funds.

Now, We experience that people are coming up with urge to contribute towards earmarked funds held for this mobility projects. At present 5 of our candidates are having their own vehicles and the fleet of special vehicles itself provided a solution to the transport problem of fellow candidates.

I sincerely feel that every child falling in physically (orthopedically) challenged category should be provided with special vehicle and become part of more inclusive society in real sense.

- Vocational Training Center
- Medical Care Unit, Pre & Post-Operative Care Unit, Recovery Room
- Physiotherapy, Gymnasium and Yoga Unit
- · Prosthetic Limb Manufacturing Unit
- Recreational facilities like Swimming, Music, Dance, Drama, Art & Craft
- Library (including Brail), Auditorium, Music Room, Computer Lab and Audio Room (Hearing Impaired)
- Horticulture, Solar Driven Projects, Water Recycling, Bio Gas Energy and Eco friendly environment
- Exposure to Natural Environment with a Green Campus
- For Severe Disabled Persons Various income generating projects within the campus will be initiated to make them Self-Reliant and lead dignified Life

Irfan Pathan hails from slum area, father working as construction labour having drinking habits and mother as maid servant. Irfan successfully continued the journey of Diploma in Art at Abhinav College of Arts, Pune for past 4 years. Irfan is appearing for final year examination this year March - April 2016. His journey of

pursuing dream seems very difficult because of his family background. But Irfan is consistently on progressive path.

He is Self Reliant for past three years and taking care of expenses required for his hostel stay, college fees, study material, transport etc on his own. Though he is having home in Pune, he required to spent lot on hostel expenses as his home prevails in slum area. He is regular in repayment of Interest Free Vehicle Loan provided to him by our organization.

Irfan's daily chorus is tremendous hectic but encouraging too. Attending college in morning, then working for self reliance in afternoon, completing assignments in evening and performing free lance work at night. Again on Sundays, taking private harmonium tuition, painting tuition. He is very aggressive in performing organizational activities too..

Yuvraj Ahire hails from slum area, father doing mochi work have drinking habits and mother as maid servant.. Yuvraj successfully continued the journey of Diploma in Electronics at Kohinoor Technical Institute, Pune after completion his 12th standard. Now Yuvraj is preparing for Government Jobs. His journey of pursuing



dream has become very difficult due to sudden health problems. His family background is also not supportive for his career instead increasing the hurdles. Still Yuvraj is continuing on progressive path.

He is Self Reliant for past three years and taking care of expenses required for his hostel stay, mess charges, transport etc on his own. Yuvraj is having home in Mumbai Slums, which increases his mobility issues as such doesn't want to go back Mumbai and wishes to settle in Pune. He is regular in repayment of Interest Free Vehicle Loan provided to him by our organization.

Yuvraj's daily chorus is tremendous hectic. Attending Tabla classes in morning, then working for self reliance for full time i.e. 9-10 hours, cooking on his own as restricted by his poor health. Again on Sundays, performing organizational activities...

Pournima Parte – Age 18 year- Paraphrasis due to meningocele, loss of bladder control - having 50% disability - hails from village Ashte, Satara District. Under Rehabilitation program, we have provided financial help for college fees...





Sayali Ingale - Age 18 years - Post Burn amputation of right hand - having 87% disability. Under Rehabilitation program, we have extended financial help for her college fees, hostel fees, study material during current academic year...

Since Sunita accomplished two years of "Self Reliance" successfully and also adequate funds were available through the repayment received from

earlier loans granted, we decided to provide her special vehicle.

#### Life Greater Than "Self"



#### Walkathon 2015 - Initiative for Awareness

Around 200 people walked along with the 18 differently abled people in support of the cause. Students and authorities of Make My Dream Foundation, Poona Blind Girls' School, LARC Special Education School, SAAD, Ankur Vidyamandir, Aadhar Karnabadhir School, Sparsh Clinic for special children, Aasha - AFMC School for special Children all were participated.
