Hello Everybody,

One more year with full of challenges, energetic activities and unforgivable experiences....

Make My Dream Foundation continued its journey along-side the underprivileged special youth with the initiatives like BAHA implant, Drawing Competition and Mobility Projects.



You are aware that Make My Dream Foundation is committed to work on all disabilities. Stepping ahead towards this, in year 2015 we have entered into the challenge of BAHA Implant Project for Omkar Kadam a hearing-impaired boy. Omkar's parents approached for corrective surgery of their ward involving huge costs, which was out of their reach. After putting in adequate time and efforts and due R&D, we successfully completed BAHA Implant for Omkar and now he can hear normally and started leading improvised social life. As a head of Make My Dream Foundation, I feel really proud of our milestone project accomplishment. This biggest challenge turned to success through the help of many more hands and I am thankful to all of them by heart. It took about one year's period to accomplish this task, so one can imagine the difficulty level involved in it.

During academic year 2016-2017, we have admitted 3 new candidates with hearing impairment. Thus, we really got exposed to this speechless world. We find most challenging to understand their world, their issues and find out solutions for it. Communication and language development are the vital issues faced by this youth. We tried to meet these guys with speech therapists, sign language experts to understand and find out solutions. But unfortunately, we find it's too late to provide proper solutions to them. So, we are restricted to the sign language option for them. Simultaneously importance of early intervention was triggered in our mind. Surprisingly, I came across recently good projects, who are involved in early intervention for hearing-impaired kids. I felt that, Yes, this is right solution to sort out basic issues of hearing-impaired and projects with early interventions should come up in numbers in near future.

In December, 2016 Mrs. Neelima Gole from USA handed over sizable amount of donation and expressed that her donation should not be spent in normal pool and be utilized for any competition and give prizes from it to the special ones. After giving thought over it, idea of conducting drawing competition came in our

mind and we started working on it. Competition kept open to candidates falling in all categories of disability. We tried to reach all schools, NGO's working in Pune and vicinity and tried that maximum special children could able to participate in the competition. We got experience like both sides of coin, still could able to reach 291 special candidates and to get themselvesexposed to their hidden potential and could able to carve out some creative ideas from their mind. We got tremendous satisfaction by looking happiness over the faces of special ones. The Competition conducted successfully in 5 schools in February 2017 and we are thankful to our special friends for giving us such unforgivable experience.

Our Mobility Project Module turned to success, giving unique perspective to the mobility issues of Orthopedic handicap candidates. The solution of interest free vehicle loan turned a right solution and made these candidates understand the correct gesture of debt and its repayment. We are successful in inculcating habit of timely repayment in these candidates and thus exposed them to recycle of funds for helping their other friends.

So, recycle of funds and benefit to many more candidates is targeted through this module. We are proud to state that we are the first who launched this module. We would once again like to state that this module is executed from the earmarked donations received against this project and with the consent of those donors.

Since past two years we are mentioning about "Gurukul" our dream project. We are in process of identification of land for "Gurukul". The budget for 2 acre is estimated at Rs. 1.00 crore. Till today we could able to save Rs. 25 lacs against it by curtailing our major administrative costs. We have not employed any single staff in last 8 years and saved a lot and managing the work with the help of volunteers. I once again sincerely appeal to all to come forward and join our hands and be a partner in our dream project. We have a far road ahead to complete our dream....

I feel deeply indebted to all supporters of Make My Dream Foundation and thankful to all by heart. Indeed, I am confident and looking forward for your unreserved support in all our upcoming endeavors and accomplishment of Phase II "Our Dream Project".....




Bachelor of Fine Arts from J.J. Institute of Applied Art Mumbai. We have financed for his educational expenses and study material.



UNIQUE PROJECT

BAHA Implant

Life changing project for Omkar where he can now hear properly. Make My Dream Foundation is glad as it helps in making this happen....

Omkar Ranjit Kadam, 16 years old student, now leads a socially active life, with his new hearing implant. Make My Dream (MMD) Foundation is proud to be part in making this happen. As MMD founder Ms. Medha Kulkarni says "Our mission is not just to provide medical aid. Instead we work towards making them self—reliant and achieve their long-term goals".



Omkar, from Gajawadi village, at the foothills of Sajjangad, was born partially deaf, missing an outer ear and ear canal in both side. This congenital defect is called bilateral microtia with bilateral moderate to severe conductive hearing loss. His parents hail from poor farmer's family had consulted with several doctors, who suggested BAHA (Bone Anchored Hearing Aid) implant, to improve his hearing, speech perception, social opportunity and quality of life. They approached Medha Kulkarni, founder of Make My Dream

Foundation, at Sonwadi-Gajawadi Village Camp, in August 2015 to assist with this operation as cost of the BAHA4 system implant was quoted Rs. 4.98 lacs.

BAHA- Bone Anchored Hearing Aid Implants, transmit the sound waves through the bones in our skull, or bone conduction, thereby bypassing the outer and middle ear. After a few more visits to doctors and research, to ascertain the risk factors, MMD decided to get enhanced BAHA implants (1.3 tesla), which offer patients a high level of MRI compatibility.

MMD approached Dr. Hetal Marfatia, ENT Surgeon from K.E.M. Hospital, Mumbai, for the operation, who helped with fund raising. Tata Trust aided with Rs. 3.63 lakhs, and Murli Laj Chungai Charity Trust Rs. 0.40 lakhs. MMD raised funds of around Rs. 1.00 lakhs towards the project.

In the meantime, Omkar was in his 10th standard. He was doing regular schooling, although his partial hearing affected his academic performance. He wanted to complete his board exams before doing the operations. He completed his 10th standard with 55% marks. MMD was also constantly giving him positive counseling, to mentally prepare him for the operation.

Finally, in August 2016, the operation was performed successfully. After completion of Austio Integration in November 2016, Omkar started hearing normally. Omkar's parents' continued efforts and MMD's financial and moral support made this happen. This was a life-changing event in Omkar's life. Now he can hear life-long.

Omkar is now pursuing B. Arts and is doing fine academically. MMD conducted an aptitude test for him where he has shown inclination and aptitude towards fine arts. MMD will assist through-out this journey, till he becomes self-reliant.

We are very much grateful to Dr. Jeevan Ladi, Dr. Mrs. Meera Mulay, Medical Student Ms. Krutika Ladi, Dr. Sandeep Athavale (ENT Surgeon) Satara, Dr. Hetal Marfatia and both the Trusts who support for finances for their valuable support and guidance in making the event successful.

We have given though over it and idea of Drawing Competition emerged in our mind. In February, 2017, we have organized 'Neelima Dilip Gole Drawing Competition' for special children prevailing under all categories of disability including cerebral palsy and mentally challenged ones. The competition was open for all Special Schools, Special Candidates situated in Pune. There was hopping response to the competition and about 291 Special Children from various Schools, NGO's participated in the event. The competition was conducted for exposing these Special Ones to their hidden potential and we are happy to see the happiness on the faces of the little one. All have enjoyed the competition to their fullest.

We got unreserved support from School Teachers, School Heads of Special Schools, Parents of Special Ones, Volunteers and of course the little ones and the event turned into success. We are thankful to all and the sponsor Mrs. Neelima Gole. Because of her, we could able to conduct such a big event. The Authorities of Agarkar High School for Girls have permitted to use their school premises for competition free of cost. We are very much thankful to them. Also Mr. Hasmukhbhai Patel has sponsored Drawing Sheets required for the competition. Thanks to Mr. Hasmukhbhai Patel.








A Milestone Project from "Dream Vision Fund"

"This year we have helped to Nilesh Wani through our "Dream Vision Fund Project". He belongs to Jalgaon. He has completed his Diploma in Civil Engineering from College of Engineering, Pune. When he was in the last



year of Diploma, his father died. He has two younger brothers and mother in the family. His mother works in the school as a cook and that is the only source of income for the family. His financial condition is so poor, that till third year of engineering he completed education with the help teachers and friends from his town. This year it was not possible. So, we have helped towards the gap of fees of Rs.5000/and helped him to reduce problems a bit. We are sure that he will succeed in his life with glory and remember us

for life time. We are very happy to help him though a small."

Projects Coming Up... GURUKUL

You are aware that we have decided to initiate our Dream Project "GURUKUL": An Independent Beginning. Gurukul will be a residential facility with approximate 20000 sq. ft. construction on 1 Acre Land within the vicinity of Pune City, Capacity to house about 50 candidates and requisite caretakers, geared towards support and strengthening of the special ones.

We are in the process of identification of land for Gurukul. The approximate budget required for this is Rs. One crore. We could able to save Rs. 25 lacs till date against the budget by curtailing our major administrative expenses on account of salaries and perquisites.

Following features shall be created in Gurukul.

- Residential arrangement closely situated to Regular Schools and Colleges
- Vocational Training Center
- Medical Care Unit, Pre & Post-Operative Care Unit, Recovery Room
- Physiotherapy, Gymnasium and Yoga Unit
- Prosthetic Limb Manufacturing Unit
- Library (including Brail), Auditorium, Music Room, Computer Lab and Audio Room (Hearing Impaired)
- Horticulture, Solar Driven Projects, Water Recycling, Bio Gas Energy and Eco friendly environment
