

Experience of execution of rehabilitation program for these candidates is a mix bag. Candidates are receiving significant help from one class of aware society, at the same time getting ominous treatment from other part of society, who even not considered them as human being & humiliate them.

We have expressed our strong views on this in our article published in 'Dainik Loksatta' on 30th November, 2011.

We are proud to state that in spite of such humiliating treatment received from the part of society, our candidates are on the path of make over and they are advancing towards their goal, which is just possible because of self healing thoughts received through our counseling.

I am glad to inform you that we are gradually stepping ahead towards implementation of Phase II, which is our dream project. As such, we are in the process of raising funds for acquisition of the land admeasuring 1 to 2 acre for the project at the outskirts of Pune city.

With these achievements, considering the number of candidates refrained from taking education after 10th due to non availability adequate support programs, we have decided to add 15 new candidates in the next academic year i.e. 2012 to 2013. Thus the total number of candidates under support will be 22 during next academic year.

One can imagine now, the budget for next academic year has been triggered up tremendously.

development sessions to the candidates since October 2011. Shri Amit Deokule, International Life Balance Coach has joined our hands for this. He introduces the candidates with their self and keeps motivated the candidates for pursuing their goals.

We are also happy to announce that all the candidates have cleared their terminal examination successfully. Everybody is aware of the vast gap between the understanding level for 10th standard and understanding level required for 11th standard. So it became challenge for us to encourage all the candidates to keep them with the pace of 11th standard and understand their domain subjects thoroughly.

We would like to mention that recently the team of students has joined our hands from Fergusson College, Pune, for English tuitions to our candidates. All are studying in 11th standard but we appreciate their enthusiasm as they are helping us by managing their own studies / examinations.

Hats of to them and their teacher Mrs. Rekha Ingalhallikar, who appealed these students and they joined us without hesitation and parting the work voluntarily. At this age they possess the thoughts to think beyond 'self'...
