A year with bundle of activities, exciting environment, energetic moments, motivating challenges ...

Make My Dream Foundation continued its journey with the initiatives like Speech Processor, Music Competition and Mobility Projects. At the same time candidates academic progress is too encouraging.

Make My Dream Foundation is committed to work along-side with all types of disabilities. Stepping ahead, in November 2017, we came across a challenging project of New Speech Processor for Purva Kadam a hearing-impaired girl. Purva's mother approached for financial support for upgrading the speech processor for her alone daughter involving huge costs as such was out of her reach. After putting in adequate efforts and due R&D, we successfully completed the project for Purva and now with this up-gradation her listening ability is for both the ears as against earlier of one ear. Now she can hear normally and started leading improvised social life. As a head of Make My Dream Foundation, I feel really proud of our one more milestone project accomplishment. This biggest challenge turned to success with the help of many more hands and I am thankful to all of them from bottom of my heart. It took only one month's period to accomplish this task, so one can imagine how swiftly the project was completed.

During academic year 2017-2018, we have admitted 5 new candidates inclusive of one hearing impaired and one partially blind. We got opportunity to expose with different disabilities. Our perspective widened from mobility to speechless and blind world. We find bit challenging to understand their world, issues and find out proper solutions for it.

Earlier I just touched the topic of early intervention. This year I didn't came across any new project with early intervention. In fact this is the vital perspective needs to interrogate every time while dealing with different types of disabilities.

With the encouraging experience of drawing competition, we felt an urge to extend platform for the hidden potential of these differently divyang children. At the outset this year we came out with the initiative of Music Competition for these special ones. In November 2017, we have decided to organize for the Music Competition "Swapn Swaranche" i.e. for vocal and instrumental. Music Competition being live performing art and essentially a creative one, we decided to arrange it in planned and organized manner. Competition kept open



to candidates falling in all categories of disability. We tried to reach all schools, NGO's working in Pune and vicinity and tried that maximum special children could able to participate in the competition. Again a magnificent response got towards the idea and about 188 entries registered for the audition round from 20 Special Schools, NGO's situated within the vicinity of Pune city. Few registrations are requested for age group 35+ also. The audition round was conducted at the doorsteps of all Special Schools / NGO's during the period 8th January, 2018 to 15th February, 2018.

The competition was conducted for exposing these Special Ones to their hidden potential and we are glad to see the happiness on the faces of the little one. They got opportunity to perform themselves and their happiness had no bounds. They were really delighted to be the part of the competition. We have undergone through a very energetic experience with full of satisfaction and happiness. It's a memorable experience and relentless efforts of all involved.

Our successful Mobility Project Module extends different perspective to the mobility issues of orthopedic handicap candidates. Providing interest free vehicle loan at right juncture turned a unique solution for the various unforeseen issues before these special ones. It helps the candidates to understand the correct gesture of debt and its repayment. We are successful in inculcating habit of timely repayment in these candidates and thus exposed them to the concept of recycle of funds in turn extending helping hand for the fellow sufferers.

Recycle of funds for the purpose of extending the help to more and more candidates is targeted through this module. We always feel proud to be the first having launched this module. We reiterate that these funds are managed from the earmarked donations received against this project and with the consent of the concerned donors.

We reiterate about "Gurukul" our dream project. Identification of land for "Gurukul" is under process. The budget for 2 acre is estimated at Rs. 1.00 crore. By curtailing our major administrative costs, we could able to reach 1/3 of the targeted amount. Now it's time to gear up the endeavors. I once again sincerely appeal to all to come forward and join our hands and be a partner in our dream project. We have a far road ahead to complete our dream....

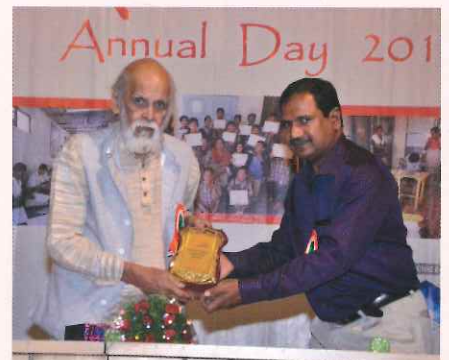
Annual Day Celebration

Make My Dream Foundation is always offering better opportunities to its candidates of 'self reliance' with need based financial support and envision idea of providing interest free loan emerged out of in depth thought of 'self reliance' and self dignity. Since July 2014, we have provided special vehicles to 3 ex-candidates i.e. Irfan Pathan, Yuvraj Ahire and Sunita Shinde under our "Mobility Project" from the "Earmarked Fund" amounting to Rs.2,40,000/- created out of special donations received from donors against "Mobility Project". We would like to state that all are regular in repayment. Sunita Shinde has repaid the loan in full.

New Speech Processor



Make My Dream Foundation is glad as it helps in making this happen....

Purva Kadam hails from Baramati is under our rehabilitation program since November 2017. While executing her program, it is understood that Purva is a case of bilateral congenital profound sensory neural 100% hearing loss.

At present Purva is in 8th standard and her mother shifted her to Pune last year for providing her better educational opportunity. Currently Purva is in Modern High School, Pune and getting special coaching in case of need. Purva's father expired in March 2008 due to cancer and now she is being taken-care by her mother alone.

In January, 2009, Purva underwent Cochlear Implant surgery at KEM Hospital, Pune under the guidance of Dr. Neelam Vaid, ENT Consultant. After speech therapy and rehabilitation, Purva became able to attend normal school and started communicating normally. Cochlear Implant helped her to become part of mainstream society.

Speech Processor provided to Purva in 2009 got out of production and its functioning was affected a lot. Hence Purva was advised for up gradation of her external speech processor to get benefit of advances in technology.

The cost of new speech processor quoted by the company was at Rs. 5,58,750/=. Purva's mother is sole earning member in the family. As such she approached Make My Dream Foundation for financial help.



Under our rehabilitation program, we have accepted the project as challenge and decided to help Purva to maintain her statuesque of hearing ability and pursue her education normally. We had enquired with the Company about clinical investigations and remedial program. They confirmed that the inside implant is of advanced version and compatible for the new up gradation of speech processor. After negotiations the company offered discount of Rs.50000/- from their side.

Then MMDF approached its valuable individual donors. Purva's mother raised Rs.1.00 lacs from relatives and could able to get aid from government of Rs. 2.00 lacs against the total project cost. Thus MMDF raised funds of Rs. 2.10 lacs towards the gap and successfully completed the project in December 2017. Purva received the new speech processor with link for both the ears. Now her listening ability is for both the ears, which will improve her social appearance remarkably.

Purva is doing fine academically. MMDF will assist through-out the journey, till she becomes self-reliant.

Few registrations are requested for age group 35+ also. To encourage to these special ones, we have allowed their performances in audition round and few were felicitated for their talent.

The audition round was conducted at the doorsteps of all Special Schools / NGO's during the period 8th January, 2018 to 15th February, 2018. All the participants were further segregated according to disability type i.e. Mentally Retarded, Autism, Cerebral Palsy and Others. Others include orthopedic, blind, learning disability etc.

We are very much thankful to all the music teachers, administrative staff of the Schools / NGO's for making available audition round at their doorsteps and taking ahead the competition smoothly and planned manner. Some Schools have permitted us to call other Schools / NGO's at their premises, eventually we could able to convene the audition round at 15 places. We are thankful to Kamayani School for MR, Dawn School, Intervida Jagriti School, Bal Kalyan Sanstha for this kind gesture.

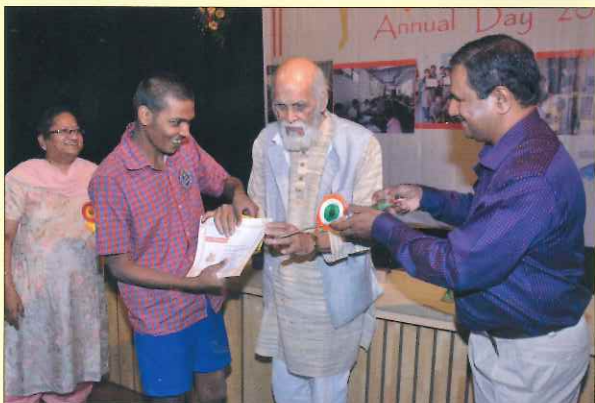

Projects Coming Up... GURUKUL

You are aware that we have decided to initiate our Dream Project "GURUKUL": An Independent Beginning. Gurukul will be a residential facility with approximate 20000 sq. ft. construction on 1 Acre Land within the vicinity of Pune City, Capacity to house about 50 candidates and requisite caretakers, geared towards support and strengthening of the special ones.

We are in the process of identification of land for Gurukul. The approximate budget required for this is Rs. One crore. We could able to save Rs. 30 lacs till date against the budget by curtailing our major administrative expenses on account of salaries and perquisites.

Following features shall be created in Gurukul.

- Residential arrangement closely situated to Regular Schools and Colleges
- Vocational Training Center
- Medical Care Unit, Pre & Post-Operative Care Unit, Recovery Room
- Physiotherapy, Gymnasium and Yoga Unit
- Prosthetic Limb Manufacturing Unit
- Library (including Brail), Auditorium, Music Room, Computer Lab and Audio Room (Hearing Impaired)
- Horticulture, Solar Driven Projects, Water Recycling, Bio Gas Energy and Eco friendly environment

For Severe Disabled Persons - Various Income Generating Projects within the campus will be initiated to make them Self-Reliant and lead Dignified Life

Awareness program of creating inclusive society shall be followed up vigorously and necessary suitable infrastructure shall be developed to have barrier free society.

Need Based Rural Support Centers shall be launched.
