What began with helping differently-abled students continue their education after 10th grade evolved into a mission of "Empowering through Education." The mental strength of these children inspired us, turning every challenge into a path of discovery. Alongside success stories came setbacks, each offering valuable lessons. We identified diverse needs within the community and explored creative, holistic approaches for their development. Over 16 years, we've observed a decline in candidates with locomotor disabilities, alongside a rise in those with hearing impairments and visual impairments, especially from rural Marathwada. As disability patterns evolve, we have adapted by prioritizing inclusivity and remain committed to offering holistic support to help individuals overcome emerging challenges and thrive.

During August – September 2025, we achieved a significant milestone by completing our third and fourth Sound Processor Replacement projects for candidate Gauri Pansare and Rituraj Belanke. We take pride in our progress, which reflects our commitment to launching at least one dedicated project each year to support individuals with hearing impairments. We strongly believe that meeting the needs of the hearing-impaired is essential in today's world, and we remain dedicated to advancing our efforts in this important area.

I am deeply thankful for the generous support from individual donors, which made last year's projects possible.

On January 19th, 2025, we achieved a remarkable win by organizing a trekking expedition for 17 hearing impaired individuals and 3 locomotor impaired individuals. This time, Make My Dream Foundation organized a trek to Sajjangad, beautifully combining the spirit of adventure with deep devotion. The experience taught candidates to embrace every situation with love and positivity, capturing the true essence of life's meaning.

After a decade of pursuit, our true dream is now close to becoming a reality. We invested great effort in finding the perfect land for Gurukul and have successfully identified a 50,000-square-foot plot in Village Sangvi Khurd, near Nasarapur. The purchase process is underway, and we expect to take possession within a month.

Acquiring land is the first step of the Gurukul Project. Ahead lies the journey of building a dream home for these divyang children and creating a transformative environment for individuals with diverse physical disabilities. This initiative will offer a comprehensive, supportive, and inclusive residential facility to improve quality of life and promote self-reliance among its residents.

Gurukul will be a platform that offers these children every opportunity to thrive. Our goal extends beyond education to instilling values of responsibility, integrity, and devotion. Through holistic development programs, mentorship, and ongoing support, we aim to empower them to become confident individuals who positively impact society and embrace a strong sense of national pride. More than just a hostel, Gurukul will provide a nurturing environment for academic, social, and moral growth. It will shape children into conscientious citizens dedicated to improving their communities and contributing to the nation's progress.

My heartfelt thanks all our supporters, CSR partners, well-wishers, volunteers, and the committed management team for your steadfast support in every endeavour. Your strong backing has enabled us to make a significant impact in the lives of individuals with disabilities. With your ongoing dedication, I am confident we will continue this journey with passion and enthusiasm, working tirelessly to build a more inclusive and empowering society. 
After completing his 10th Standard at Nakoda Karnbadhir Vidyalaya, Bhivandi, Akash continued his educational journey. With the

SOUND PROCESSOR

Sound Processor – Project III - 2024

Gauri Pansare from Ahmednagar, of age 13 is a case of bilateral congenital profound sensory neural 100% hearing loss by birth.

In 2016, Gauri underwent Cochlear Implant surgery. Gauri integrated in normal school and started communicating near normal speech. Cochlear Implant helped her to remain part of mainstream society.



Functioning of Sound Processor provided to Gauri in 2016 got badly affected since January 2024 requiring huge amount for repairs. Hence Gauri was advised for up gradation of sound processor. The cost of new sound processor was of Rs. 3,12,900/=. Gauri's father being sole earning member in the family approached Make My Dream Foundation for financial assistance. He raised hand loans and put own contribution of Rs. 2.13 lacs but still shortfall of Rs. 1,00,000.00. Make My Dream Foundation raised funds of Rs. 1.00 lacs towards the gap and successfully completed the project in August 2024.



Gauri is pursuing her 7th standard studies at Ahmednagar. She could continue her education with our timely help.

We are very much grateful to Shirish Dasnurkar and Associates, who donated matching amount towards the project and helped us to make it happen.

Sound Processor – Project IV - 2024

Ruturaj Belanke from Kolhapur, of age 13 is a case of bilateral congenital profound sensory neural 100% hearing loss by birth.

In 2016, Ruturaj underwent Cochlear Implant surgery. Ruturaj integrated in normal school and started communicating near normal speech. Cochlear Implant helped him to remain part of mainstream society.



Functioning of Sound Processor provided to Ruturaj in 2016 got badly affected since May 2024 requiring huge amount for repairs. Hence Ruturaj was advised for up gradation of sound processor. The cost of new sound processor was of Rs. 3,12,900/=. Ruturaj's father being sole earning member in the family approached Make My Dream Foundation for financial assistance. He raised hand loans and put own contribution of Rs. 1.90 lacs but still shortfall of Rs. 1,22,900.00. Make My Dream Foundation raised entire funds towards the gap and successfully completed the project in October 2024.



Ruturaj is pursuing his 7th standard studies at Kolhapur. He could continue his education with our timely help.

We are very much grateful to Mrs. Nileema Varadan, Mr. Vivek Apte, Mr. Vinod Kulkarni and Dr. Milind Kulkarni, who donated matching amount towards the project and helped us to make it happen.

CURRENT SUPPORT PROGRAM

Established on March 27, 2009, the Make My Dream Foundation is dedicated to the comprehensive rehabilitation of physically challenged children from economically disadvantaged backgrounds. Our mission encompasses several key objectives:

- 1. Empowerment through Education and Self-Reliance:** We strive to empower physically challenged children by providing them with access to education and fostering self-confidence, enabling them to fully participate in and contribute to an inclusive society.
- 2. Enhanced Infrastructure for Mobility:** To work towards creating basic infrastructure that facilitates hassle-free mobility for individuals with disabilities, ensuring they can navigate the world with ease and independence.
- 3. Raising Awareness and Advocacy:** Through community outreach and education initiatives, we seek to raise awareness about the genuine needs of various disabled communities. We advocate for their rights and opportunities, promoting a society where all individuals can live with dignity.
- 4. Establishment of a Rehabilitation Centre:** Our goal is to establish a comprehensive Rehabilitation Centre dedicated to providing tailored support and resources for physically challenged children, facilitating their physical, emotional, and social development.

In the fiscal year 2022-2023, in alignment with our commitment to inclusivity, we have expanded our focus to include the rehabilitation of economically disadvantaged individuals without physical disabilities. This expansion reflects our dedication to fostering a truly inclusive society where everyone, regardless of their physical abilities, has the opportunity to thrive.

Phase I – Current Project

Phase I of our initiative is for empowering 10th-grade students with physical challenges to pursue higher or vocational education, fostering self-reliance and dignity through personalized counselling. To date, we have successfully rehabilitated 68 candidates, with 9 currently enrolled in the 2024-2025 fiscal year. Our financial assistance covers educational expenses, accommodation, transportation, study materials, and other essentials, supporting candidates until they complete their mainstream education while promoting a healthy lifestyle.

The program begins with an aptitude test and counselling sessions to help candidates explore educational paths aligned with their strengths and interests. Candidates independently select their educational streams, with our unwavering support throughout the admission process into mainstream colleges, fostering inclusive learning environments.

Our candidates pursue diverse fields such as engineering, fine arts, commerce, tourism, horticulture, crèche and pre-school management, culinary arts, music, and electronics/IT. Remarkably, 50 out of the 68 graduates are now leading independent lives—some enjoying fulfilling marriages, while others prepare for competitive examinations.

Our one-on-one counselling approach is instilling the belief that despite physical challenges, candidates possess sound mental health and the potential to thrive. We emphasize that financial and social support from the Make My Dream Foundation is an opportunity, not a limitation. Phase II – Upcoming Project - Gurukul

Make My Dream Foundation is embarking on its ambitious Dream Project titled "Gurukul: An Independent Beginning." Gurukul will be a residential facility designed to support and empower both physically challenged (divyang) individuals and economically disadvantaged individuals who are physically normal. Spanning approximately 35,000 square feet on a one-acre plot near Pune City, Gurukul aims to accommodate over 50 candidates alongside essential caretakers, while also serving as a vibrant residential cultural centre.

Key features of Gurukul include:

- ◆ Residential accommodation strategically located near mainstream schools and colleges.
- ◆ Vocational training facilities.
- ◆ A comprehensive medical care unit with provisions for pre and postoperative care as well as recovery services.
- ◆ Facilities for physiotherapy, a gymnasium, and yoga sessions.
- ◆ A dedicated unit for manufacturing prosthetic limbs.
- ◆ Resources such as a library with Braille books, an audio room for the hearing impaired, music rooms, art and craft sections, a computer lab, an auditorium, and a swimming pool.
- ◆ Emphasis on environmental sustainability with initiatives like horticulture, solar-powered projects, water recycling, bio-gas energy, and creating an eco-friendly environment.

For individuals with severe disabilities - Gurukul will create income generating various projects within the campus to promote self-reliance and dignity.


Income Source
